- Conduct market research on carbon pricing regimes, forecasts and their impact on industries
- Lead due diligence on investment opportunities
- Lead the execution of financial models, project finance/ infrastructure models, valuation analyses, and any additional needed financial analyses
- Lead the preparation and presentation of proposals and pitchbooks
- Source and evaluate potential investment opportunities
- Ad hoc responsibilities consistent with a growing and evolving function

- A University undergraduate Degree in a related field (Finance, Engineering, Accounting, or Science)
